arriage Driving has been an important part of RDA since 1975 and there are now over 60 groups throughout the UK, giving driving opportunities to over 1000 drivers. It is also enjoyed by people who can no longer ride due to disability, or who prefer a different kind of equine challenge.

Each group has specialised vehicles which take both ambulant and non-ambulant drivers. Wheelchairs and adaptations to the harness cater for the needs of all.

At this year's Virtual Championships, we are offering three classes for Novice, Intermediate and Open competitors who will just drive a dressage test. Normally competitors would be asked to do a cones course followed by 2 or 4 obstacles.

The objective of the driven dressage test is to judge the freedom, regularity of paces, harmony, impulsion, suppleness, lightness, ease of movement and correct bending of the horses on the move. Drivers will also be judged on style, accuracy and general control of their horses, and on their dress, condition of their harness and carriage and the presentation of the whole turnout.

#### DRESSAGE 1

ressage offers the opportunity for riders to show a judge, parents, friends and helpers what has been achieved during RDA sessions. It can also help a coach to set goals, allowing the riders to demonstrate often hidden reservoirs of determination to achieve and can vividly show the benefits of previous instruction.

Dressage plays a huge part of the Virtual National Championships with a variety of classes on offer this year. We have increased the number of led classes this year to include classes with side walkers as well. Grades 1-5 and B1-B5 are being run through Dressage Anywhere which is an exciting partnership that has formed this year.

Participants can ride tests in walk only, walk and trot or walk, trot and canter. They ride a specific test with a predetermined pattern in a 20m x 40m arena. A judge marks the test, they give marks out of ten for each movement set out in the test, at the end of the test the marks are added up and the winner is the combination with the highest score.

'he Musical Ride and Carriage Drive classes have been running for a number of years before we started our Virtual Championships. They are a great way for groups to get involved with from a team perspective.

There are two ridden classes on offer and one driven Each entry should present a drill ride or carriage drive with riders and helpers smartly dressed using modest fancy dress if they wish too to reflect the drill ride they are demonstrating.

Music has been shown to be a powerful element to improve and energise the performance of both horse and rider or carriage driver and each year the judges look forward to seeing a wider use of music and movements to do just that.



#### PERFORMANCE SHOWING

### Supported by Oliver Wight EAME LLP



Performance Showing is designed to introduce the rider to conducting individual displays plus exposing the newer combinations to the ring teaching manners and discipline. These classes provide vital exposure and act as a stepping stone to dressage.

The class is judged as follows:

- **50%** suitability of horse for rider and harmony shown between the two.
- 40% on manners and way of going.
- 10% on cleanliness and turnout of horse and rider.

Conformation is not considered





The competition is open to all RDA riders who can walk and trot.

Classes will be judged on turnout: cleanliness and condition of equine and tack, suitability of equine for the rider and job and overall impression.

The show should comprise of a short video of the whole horse stood still including legs and body. The rider should then move onto an individual display; to include walk, trot and canter if applicable and change of rein.

Riders should be neatly presented, clean and tidy. Saddlery should be suitable for the rider and horse to be comfortable and go correctly.

DA Showjumping has its own unique pathway giving participants valuable opportunities to take part in RDA Competitions and RDA Showjumping Proficiency Tests. The pathway entails of 5 levels, beginning at poles on the ground through to an 80cm course, catering for all.

Showjumping has proved to be a popular discipline within RDA and now has over 140 Groups taking part in level 2 or above and all groups are now able to take part in level 1, it is set to soar in the coming years.

We will be showcasing levels 1, 2, 3 and 4 at the Virtual National Championships this year.

### **VAULTING** Supported by JM Finn

aulting is best described as gymnastics and dance on horseback. At all times, the aim is for the vaulters to achieve perfect harmony with the horse whilst demonstrating their strength, flexibility, balance and creativity. Vaulting classes are offered for teams of six vaulters, for pairs, and for individuals, with options to perform on the horse or on the barrel. When competing on the horse, the lunger is in control of the horse, and is therefore a crucial part of the team!

Vaulters show as great a variety of moves as possible in their freestyles, which are performed to music. This variety is achieved by working on different parts of the horse, using different types of body position (e.g. kneeling and standing), and facing different directions. Individual vaulters also perform a set routine ("compulsories") before their freestyle.

Vaulting is immensely adaptable and is therefore perfect for people with all kinds of disabilities.
